<p>If you registered before the event, the t-shirts will be issued to you before the start of the race at pick-up.</p> <p>NOTE: base on this year’s registrations, there will be plenty of t-shirts for all registered participants. However, late registration t-shirts will be provided after the start of the run.</p>	<p>CHECK YOUR BIB</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• As with most new participants, there are occasions where people decide to exchange bibs or bibs are distributed to the wrong person. You are responsible for making sure you have the correct bib.• Allow plenty of time to pick up you bib. If you do not wear the bib assigned to you, the time may not be accurate when checking the results.

LATE REGISTRATION

Remember to make sure you are entering your correct date of birth when you register. There will be division award provided to both makes and females in each age category.

T-SHIRTS

T-shirts will be distributed on race day, Saturday, March 23, 2024, in the expo area location across from the start/finish in the Arroyo South Baseball Field area. Late registrants will need to wait to get their t-shirets after the start of the race.

BIB ASSIGNMENTS

Bib number will not be pre-assigned. Participant bibs will be assigned at packet pick-up using dynamic bib assignment. Volunteers will check in runners and assign the bib number at this time.

PARKING

Allow plenty of time to get to the registration area and pick up your bib and t-shirt. Arrive early and factor in traffic to ensure you make it to the start line on time.

There is plenty of parking around the park and in the neighboring streets. Limited parking next to the main venue on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Note: for those parking on Arroyo Drive, you can easily access the main expo area by walking down the path through the 110 FWY tunnel (see the map). Staff will be in the area to direct you.

GENERAL PARKING

Volunteer drop off allowed in the main entrance to the VIP, Vendor, and Staff parking. You will need to park in the designated general parking areas.

Exhibitors / Vendors: You can only access the designated parking area by showing the pass provided or being checking in. The staff at the main entrance from Stoney Drive will have your name on the list for entry.














General parking is located on Stoney Drive and San Pascual, North of the baseball field, and on Arroyo Drive (overflow parking). Follow the signs that will be directing you with staff at the main entrance to the park.

COURSE INFORMATION

STARTING LINE

Runners are encouraged to begin lining up no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the race you signed up for.

Line up according to your expected race pace. Faster runners should be positioned at the front of the start chute, while slower runners/walkers/ strollers start at the back. The goal is to have the start flow nice and safe. Remember, you are being chip-timed.

COURSE DESIGN

5K Race is a course on compact trails along the historic Arroyo Seco. The 1K is also on tree-lined trails along the Arroyo Seco Golf Course. Water stations are located at the halfway mark on both the 5K and 10K courses.

RECOVERY WATER STATIONS

Water will be available at the halfway mark on the route and at the finish/start. Electrolytes at the finish line.

FIRST AID SUPPORT

We will have a roving first aid team available to cover the main portion of the 5K. First aid station is also available in the main expo area.

FINISH LINE

The finish line is located near the expo area.

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FINISH LINE EXPO

The finish line is open to all participants and spectators. Join us! Located next to the finish/start. The expo features a music festival, food trucks, vendors, an award ceremony and 50th Anniversary Celebration!
